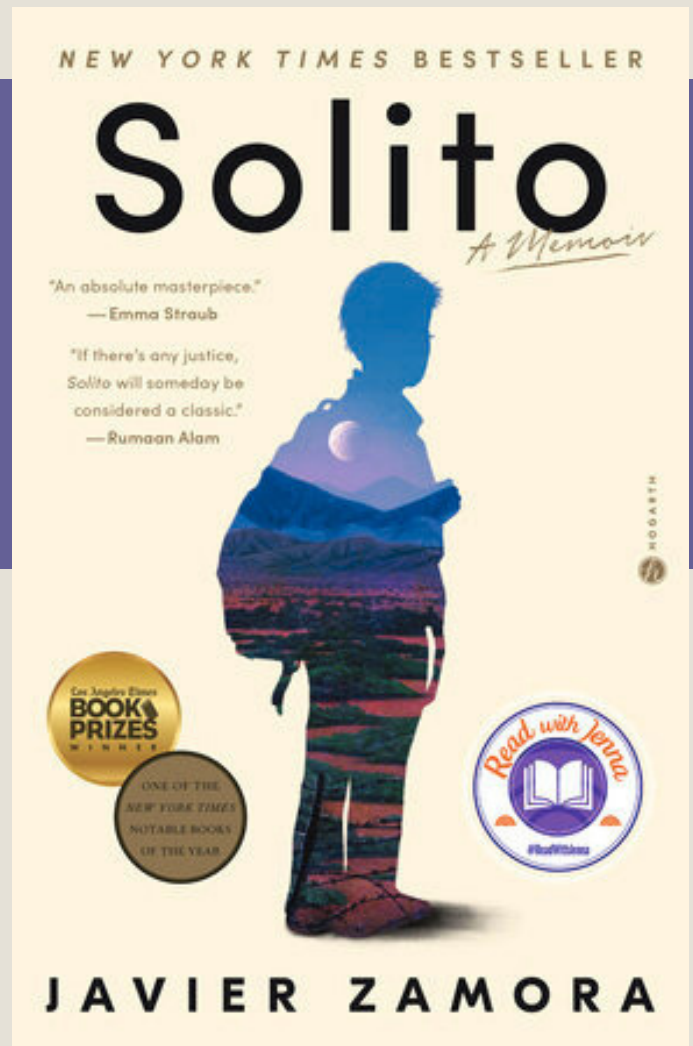


SOCIAL JUSTICE TASK FORCE ZOOM BOOK STUDY

Solito is Javier Zamora's powerful memoir of his childhood journey from El Salvador to the United States. Told through the eyes of a nine-year-old, the story weaves together memories of family left behind, the peril and hope of migration, and the unexpected bonds of love, friendship, and solidarity that arise along the way. The desert emerges as both refuge and threat—a place of survival and of profound risk. Through a child's perspective, themes of memory, imagination, language, and cultural identity deepen the narrative, offering a moving account of resilience and the search for belonging.
